TUITION FEES

- One hour of tap & ballet or tap & jazz (preschool – 1st grade) **\$670** (\$335/\$335)
- One & a half hours of tap, jazz, and ballet (2nd grade and up) **\$816** (\$408/\$408)
- Two hours of tap, jazz, extended ballet **\$976** (\$488/\$488)
- 45 minutes of hip hop (kindergarten and up) **\$520** (\$260/\$260)

* Classes do fill up. I will be holding spots until July 31. If registration is not received by then, I will release any unclaimed spots.

** If your child wishes to discontinue with classes at any point, please let me know as soon as possible. If it is before 6 weeks, I will prorate the classes taken and return the difference. If it is beyond 6 weeks, you will forfeit the first half of tuition.

*** Payment is due at registration. The class runs the full year. As a courtesy, you may pay half of the tuition with registration and the balance will be due in January 2018. Please make all checks payable to Nicole Savino. If you would prefer to pay in cash, please submit the registration form with a note and payment will be due at the first lesson.

DANCEWEAR REQUIREMENTS

Please supply the following:

Shoes

White Tap Shoes (5th grade and older will wear tan shoes with 1½ inch heel)

Pink Ballet Slippers

White Jazz Shoes (for both jazz and hip hop)

Outfits

Preschool- pink leotard, pink tights, skirts optional

Kindergarten & up- dark leotard (black, navy, purple, etc.), pink tights, skirts optional

Hip Hop- casual clothes (shorts, yoga pants, tank tops, t-shirts -NO JEANS)

* There are a couple of local stores that carry dance attire. Two stores I recommend are Repertoire in Scarsdale and Beam and Barre in Cos Cob.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

In addition to tuition, there are two other monetary requirements through the year: Parents will be responsible for purchasing the costumes and any props/accessories that go with it. The children will be measured in December and costumes will be ordered over the winter break. In the rare case that your child wishes to discontinue with classes at any point, it is the parents' responsibility to inform me. If the costume has already been ordered, it will be the parents' responsibility to cover either the cancellation fee or the full costume cost if there is no time to cancel.

Parents will be responsible for purchasing tickets to the dance recital. Tickets are assigned and non-refundable.

You will also have the option of signing your child up for picture day. It is not a requirement, but it is recommended, as it makes a nice keepsake. This day is not set yet, but will be in May.

SCHEDULE

All classes meet weekly beginning the week of September 24 and will run through the end of May. Classes will follow the Harrison School Calendar. If there is no school, or a snow day, the Purchase Community House is closed as well. This does not apply to Superintendent's conference days. The Purchase Community House also has a few days that they are closed for activities in addition to the school holidays (please see the schedule of dates below.) If there are any changes or amendments made to the schedule, I will do my very best to give as advanced notification as possible. In addition, it will be permissible for me to take three sick or personal days throughout the year if the need arises. Please rest assured I will only use these days in emergency situations.
