ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

In addition to tuition, there are two other monetary requirements through the year. Parents will be responsible for purchasing the costumes and any props/accessories that go with it. I will measure the children in early December and take care of ordering everything over the holiday break. In the rare event that your child chooses to discontinue with class, it is the parent's responsibility to let me know. If the costumes have already been ordered, it will be the parents responsibility to either cover the cancellation fee or the full cost if cancellation is not an option.

Parents will also be responsible to purchase tickets to the dance recital. Seats are assigned and non-refundable. Ticket orders will take place in May and will be processed in the order they are received.

There is also a photo day in spring. Participation is completely optional, though the pictures really do make a nice memory.

ABSENCES/MAKEUP CLASSES

Unfortunately, we all get sick sometimes. If your child misses class, there will be no makeup classes since each class is only offered once a week. I will spend time making sure the class progresses as a group and noone falls behind. If your child is out for an extended time, we can arrange for private lessons to get them up to speed. I will have the ability to take 3 sick days (per class), which I will only use if absolutely necessary throughout the year.
